Gucci, private jets, guns and cocaine! Photos show how El Chapo's fugitive son is living a lavish life despite being on the DEA's most wanted list - as his drug lord father's trial is set to begin

The fugitive son of infamous Mexican drug lord Joaquin '<u>El Chapo</u>' Guzman Loera has been living a very lavish life as he brazenly shows off his wealth, guns and drugs on social media while his father languishes in a New York prison.

Jesus Alfredo Guzman-Salazar, who is one of the 10 most wanted fugitives on the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration's list, frequently shares photos on Instagram showcasing his luxurious lifestyle in Mexico.


The 35-year-old - commonly known as 'Alfredillo' - also regularly pays tribute to his drug lord father, praising him as his best friend and a 'great person' who 'helps the poor'.

In a series of posts on his private Instagram page, which boasts 35,000 followers, Alfredo has shamelessly shared photos of his collection of luxury cars, private jets and Gucci purchases.

He also regularly shares photos of piles of cash spread out on the bed or floor, as well as containers of bullets and his high-powered rifles.


In one post, Alfredo even shared a shot of what appeared to be lines of cocaine on the cover of a book - Los Senores Del Narco - which has his father's face plastered on the front.

Despite being a fugitive, Alfredo regularly tags his location on Instagram including from as far as Italy. In one post taken in Verona, Italy, Alfredo captioned it: 'While they are looking for me as dogs in Mexico, one has fun'.


His social media profile pinpoints him as being located in the city of Zapopan near Guadalajara.

Alfredo has regularly praised his father on social media ever since the 61-year-old was extradited to the United States in January last year.

He is one of El Chapo's six sons from various marriages. His mother, Alejandrina María Salazar Hernández, was El Chapo's first wife.



In a father's day post written in Spanish from June, Alfredo described his father as a 'great person'.


'Today father's day is for me very painful not being able to be next to that great human being called Joaquin Guzman Loera,' the translated post read.



Like his father who evaded authorities for years, Alfredo was added to a list last month of fugitives sought by the DEA. The reward for his capture has been increased to \$5 million.

He is wanted in Chicago on federal drug-conspiracy distribution charges after being indicted with his father and other leaders of the Sinaloa drug cartel back in 2015.


His last known location is listed as 'unknown' on the DEA's website.

Alfredo's father is accused of running the Sinaloa crime syndicate and has been held in New York since being extradited to the U.S. on January 19, 2017, after twice escaping from prison in Mexico.

He has been charged with 17 crimes, including leading the extremely dangerous Sinaloa drug cartel and transporting at least 200,000 kilos of cocaine to the US from Mexico.

El Chapo's trial is slated to start on November 5.



The party featured huge arches made of pink balloons and an abundance of Barbie paraphernalia.

A ballroom with a chandelier was redesigned to be a giant pink Barbie Dreamhouse, complete with pink cakes, candy and a large Barbie neon sign.

Some Mexicans reacted with fury after news of the lavish birthday party emerged as they accused the former beauty queen of using 'blood money' from her 61-year-old husband's drug empire.
